Analysis of the Results of Parish Plan Questions.

Likes: - total.60.

3 comments upon communication, one positive about WIFI and the others pleased with WhatsApp groups, Village Hut News and general flow of information.

23 referred to the Community, broadly very positive about the community spirit, friendliness, the Village Hut activities in particular and the Pub. The WI and the Church were also mentioned.

34 related to the Environment. Close to beautiful countryside, with good walks. Little or no crime, peaceful and with limited new build development.

People like the easy access to services but far enough away to maintain the rural unspoilt feel. The term Peaceful was used on quite a number of occasions.

Dislikes: - total 48.

8. Related to parking, roadside and parking on bends particularly. 9 respondents identified speeding as an important issue. Dog fouling, fly tipping, no street lights and poor mobile reception were commented upon.

Improvements: - total. 54.

Many of these comments reflect dislikes expressed.

Speed limit reduced to 20mph, traffic calming, stopping people parking on the corner coming into and out of village. Stopping people from parking on pavements and more parking off road on driveways.

Better bus services are seen to be required both frequency and destinations. Publicity for making people aware of planning applications and children's play facilities were mentioned and concern over development.

Summary: - Of those responding most really liked the Parish environment its location and its community.

Anti-social and dangerous parking are major concerns as too is the speed that vehicles travel through the village at. There are numerous other dislikes and improvements but these are generally an individual's opinion rather than a widely felt concern.
